

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Uniform booth facilities include backdrop and side drops and frame for hanging drapes, one 110-volt electrical outlet and the firm name in a uniform panel on the backdrop, night watchman and janitor services. Price of outdoor space is net and does not include any of the above-mentioned extras except night watchman.
2. All improvements, foundations and buildings erected on said space or spaces shall be done at the expense of the Exhibitor, subject to approval by PBIOS. In the event of discontinuance of an exhibit, all said improvements, foundations and buildings shall be removed at the expense of the Exhibitor, leaving the space or spaces in as good condition as when contracted for, and Exhibitor's failure to do this after the due notice from show management shall constitute forfeiture of all rights and claims of Exhibitors on said improvements. In event of Exhibitor's failure to vacate space or spaces, as hereinbefore provided, then and in that event, the PBIOS, may and is hereby authorized to remove such exhibit and sore it at the Exhibitor's expense.
3. Exhibitor will not be permitted to exhibit any article other than articles manufactured or sold by it.
4. PBIOS reserves the right to remove from buildings or grounds any exhibit, concession or show that may be falsely entered or may be deemed unsuitable or objectionable, or to remove any sign, banner or advertising matter of any kind which may be deemed unsuitable by it without assigning a reason therefore.
5. Exhibitor wishing to use special electrical signs must make application for, and obtain in writhing, the consent of PBIOS.
6. **No portion of an exhibit or goods used in an exhibit may be removed from grounds or buildings at any time from the opening until the closing (at 4:00pm, Thursday) of the Permian Basin International Oil Show except in the case of extreme emergency and then only upon written permission properly signed by PBIOS. Violation of this rule shall result in the automatic forfeiture of the violating Exhibitor right to participate in subsequent Permian Basin Oil International Show Exhibitions.**
7. Public passageways remain under the control of PBIOS and no demonstrations, trophies, decorations, portals, foundations, signs, banners, advertising matter or special exhibits will be permitted in aisles, avenues, or other public passage-ways, except by special permission of PBIOS. No Exhibitor will be permitted to display products in such a manner as to obstruct the light and view through avenues or aisles, or occasion injury to, or inconvenience or disadvantageously affect the display of other Exhibitors. *For this reason, side partitions (between booths) extending from front toward the rear of the booth for a distance of five feet shall not exceed 48 inches in height.*
8. Subject to the rules and regulations established by Ector County, special utility connections and uses for lights, water and gas, will be made at Exhibitor's expense except as provided elsewhere herein. Ordinary cost of water, gas and electrical power will be paid by PBIOS.
9. PBIOS reserves the right to restrict exhibits which, because of noise or other reason, become objectionable; and also to prohibit any exhibit which in sole discretion of PBIOS may detract from the general character of the Permian Basin International Oil Show. This reservation includes persons, things, conduct, printed matter, or anything which might be objectionable to PBIOS.
10. Three days will be allowed the Exhibitors to move in and set up the exhibit before opening date of the Permian Basin International Oil Show. Two days will be allowed to remove the exhibit. Any exception to this provision must be approved by PBIOS.
11. No background, partition or sign atop any partition may exceed 8 feet in height. PBIOS reserves the right to allow an exception to this rule in the case of written request and approval.
12. Exhibitor shall not serve, sell or give away, or permit to be served, sold or given away at or near the space or spaces leased, or in connection with the exhibit, any intoxicants. The violation of this rule shall entitle PBIOS to close exhibit and remove and store the same in the manner provided above.
13. No automobiles, trucks, wagons, carry-all's, or other self-propelled or horse-drawn vehicles other than those actually on exhibit, will be permitted within show grounds, except on Exhibitor's parking space, as provided. Vehicles used in the actual operation of delivering foodstuffs and supplies to the show grounds are accepted by approval.
14. These rules and regulations are subject to revision by PBIOS.
15. **No children under 16 years of age** are allowed to attend the Permian Basin International Oil Show, unless as part of an educational group certified by the PBIOS Education Committee and escorted by its designated teacher and a representative of the PBIOS.
